On February 1, 2006 three US Postal Service Vehicles were broken into. The break-ins occurred between 10:00AM and 1:30PM at the following locations:

- Intersection of S. Champion and Newton, Zip code 43205 (10:00AM)
- Intersection of Fairwood Avenue and Kent, Zip Code 43205(12:50PM)
- Intersection of Fairwood and Forest, Zip Code 43206 (1:00PM)

No property was taken in the first break-in. Personal property belonging to the mail carrier was taken in the second break-in. Approximately 800 pieces of mail were stolen in the last break-in at Fairwood and Forest, Zip Code 43206. This would have included numerous "first of the month" checks.

Four male blacks, one wearing a ski-mask were seen fleeing the area of Fairwood and Forest and the area of Fairwood and Kent. They were also seen getting into a white Buick in the area of Fairwood and Forest.
